

A workshop in memory of Prof. Ulrich Schmucker in the Herz-Jesu Monastery in Neustadt/Germany from June 26-28, 2009



Prof. Ulrich Schmucker (July 21, 1930 – October 27, 2008)

Prof. Ulrich Schmucker died suddenly and unexpectedly in Beijing during the 19. workshop on electromagnetic induction. He was one of the pioneers of the research area “electromagnetic depth sounding”. His visions and insight inspired the electromagnetic research community for more than four decades.

In memory of Ulrich, his former students and colleagues organize an international workshop. All his colleagues are invited to this workshop, especially those who have worked with Ulrich or who share common remembrances.

The workshop will take place in the Herz-Jesu Monastery in Neustadt/Weinstraße, Germany from June 26.-28., 2009. It will begin with a dinner on the 26th June. Presentations about memories and scientific works related with Ulrich will be arranged on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Saturday afternoon a walking tour is planned. The workshop will end after lunch on Sunday.

We expect about 70 participants. 28 single and 22 double rooms are available in the monastery.
